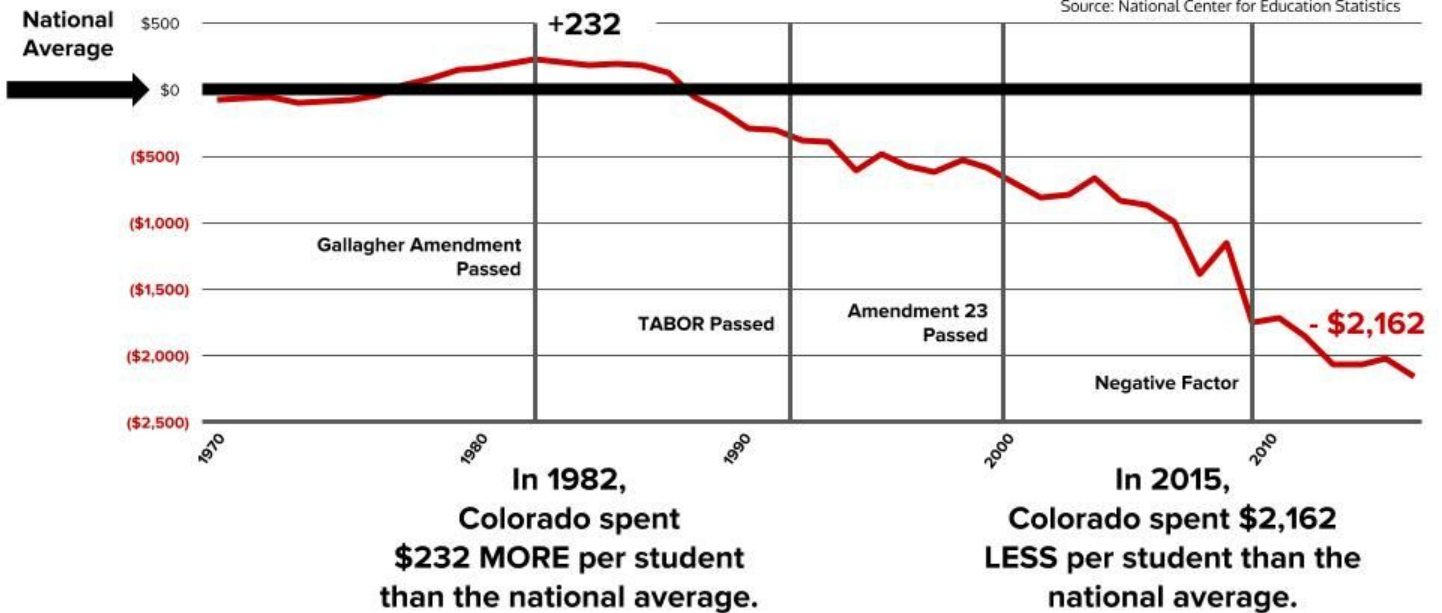




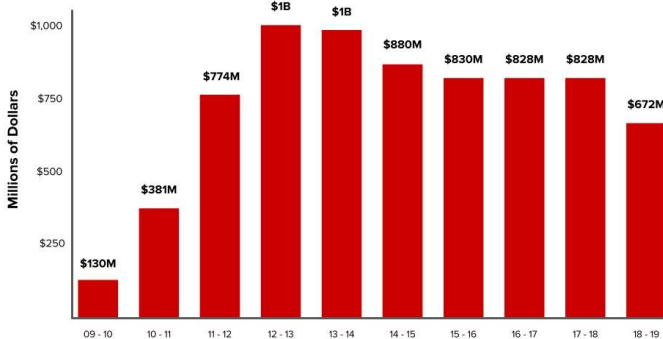

Colorado has a long history of underfunding public schools. Reaching the national average would cost \$2.1 - 2.8 billion annually. We're not only behind the national average, current funding is \$672 million behind inflation from 2008.
